### DONATION DRIVES

Catholic Community Services of Utah (CCS) provides over 400,000 services to households in need in Utah *every year*. Our 10 life-sustaining programs assist the poor, refugee, homeless, immigrant, veteran, and many more reach self-sufficiency. **Our donors are what make our services possible!** Please review the list of much-needed items below and consider how you, your neighborhood, your school or your business can help.

#### Refugee Resettlement & Immigration

- **Hygiene Kits:** kits are given to our newly refugee clients. Kits can be assembled in a plastic zip lock bag. Items: toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, conditioners, comb, small towel, washcloth, soap, deodorant, lotion, razor, shaving cream, etc.
- **School Supply Kits:** kits are given to our new refugee children and low-income children. Assemble items in backpack and indicate if elementary, junior high or high school level. Items: notebooks, construction paper, pencils, pens, scissors (all ages), erasers, crayons, colored pencils, pencil boxes, rules, pocket calculators, backpack, etc.
- **Household Kits:** kits are given to our newly arrived refugee families. Items: furniture (*new or slightly used*- couch, chairs, kitchen table & chairs, end tables, dresser, night stand, lamps, microwaves, etc.), kitchen (*new*- utensils, dishes, pots & pans, mixing & serving bowls, can opener, etc), towels and linens (*new*- face, hand & bath towels, bed sheets, pillow cases, blankets, kitchen towels, washcloths, shower curtains, etc.).
- **House Cleaning Kits:** kits are given to our newly arrived refugee families. Items: cleaning supplies, soap, laundry detergent, windex, liquid dish soap, sponges, paper towels, toilet paper, shower curtain & hooks, shelf liner, buckets, trash bags, mops, brooms, etc.

***All Refugee Resettlement donations should be dropped off at our Refugee Resettlement Share house (440 S. 400 W., SLC 84101) Monday & Wednesday from 9:00 am – 5:00 pm, Tuesday & Thursday, 9:00 am – 7:00 pm and Fridays 9:00 am to noon.***

#### Homeless Services

- **Hygiene Kits:** kits are given to our newly refugee, low-income/homeless, and treatment clients. Kits can be assembled in a plastic zip lock bag. Items: toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, conditioners, comb, small towel, washcloth, soap, deodorant, lotion, razor, shaving cream, etc.

- **School Supply Kits:** kits are given to our new refugee children and low-income children. Assemble items in backpack and indicate if elementary, junior high or high school level. Items: notebooks, construction paper, pencils, pens, scissors (all ages), erasers, crayons, colored pencils, pencil boxes, rules, pocket calculators, backpack, etc.
