Homeless Services

- **SVDP Kitchen & Dining Hall:**
  - Large size containers of; salt, pepper & Italian Seasoning. Chicken and beef bouillon
  - Toilet paper, napkins, plastic gloves for food preparation and sandwich bags.
  - Paper plates and cups.
  - Metal forks.
- **Cleaning Supplies:** laundry detergent, fabric softener or sheets.
- **Clothing Closet:** *MEN & WOMEN's* clothing. Working boots, tennis shoes, levis, sweat shirts and pants, heavy and light shirts, socks, new underwear, belts, umbrellas, sunblock and chap stick.
- **Hygiene Kits:** kits are given to our newly refugee, low-income/homeless, and treatment clients. Kits can be assembled in a plastic zip lock bag. Items: toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, conditioners, comb, small towel, washcloth, soap, deodorant, lotion, razor, shaving cream, etc.

Northern Utah Services

- **Non-perishable food items,** baby food & pet food
- **Hygiene Items:** Feminine hygiene products, toilet paper, toothpaste, toothbrushes, shampoo, combs, razors, shaving cream, soap & deodorant. We also take travel-sized items, either individually or preassembled into kits in plastic, sealable bags.
- **St. Martha's Baby Layette:** *Only new items, please* – Outfits, sleepers & onesies (size newborn or 0-3 month), diapers (newborn), wet wipes, quilts, receiving blankets, burp cloths, bibs, socks, baby toys,
- **Bridging the Gap pantry packs:** Weekend food bags given to local, low-income students contain six meals and four snacks. Items include individual serving meals (ravioli, etc.), tuna, mac & cheese, oatmeal packets, ramen, granola bars, fruit snacks, applesauce, peanut butter crackers and shelf-stable milk. *Please contact CCS for specific items & assembly instructions.*
- **School Supplies (June-Aug):** New backpacks, binders, pencil boxes, pencils, pens, glue, markers, scissors, notebooks, crayons, etc.; or **Winter Coats (Oct-Nov),** scarves, gloves & hats for ages 5-18.
