Our 10 life-sustaining programs assist the poor, refugee, homeless, immigrant, veteran, and many more reach self-sufficiency. **Our donors are what make our services possible!** Please review the list of much-needed items below and consider how you, your neighborhood, your school or your business can help.

- **SVDP Kitchen & Dining Hall:**
 - Large size containers of; salt, pepper & Italian Seasoning. Chicken and beef bouillon
 - Toilet paper, napkins, plastic gloves for food preparation and sandwich bags.
 - Paper plates and cups.
 - Metal forks.
- **Cleaning Supplies:** laundry detergent, fabric softener or sheets.
- **Clothing Closet:** **MEN & WOMEN's** clothing. Working boots, tennis shoes, levis, sweat shirts and pants, heavy and light shirts, socks, new underwear, belts, umbrellas, sunblock and chap stick.
- **Hygiene Kits:** kits are given to our newly refugee, low-income/homeless, and treatment clients. Kits can be assembled in a plastic zip lock bag. Items: toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, conditioners, comb, small towel, washcloth, soap, deodorant, lotion, razor, shaving cream, etc.
